 We as humans, not as service designers, are responsible for guiding and facilitating reflected change for the good of our people, our companies, our communities, our nations and our planet




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### Not everything has to be digital.

Digitalization comes with a price and it's time to get critical about it.








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### Trans-discipline professionals are a thing
